

All presenters at UK-CLC3 are invited to submit papers of 5-7000 words. Papers should be submitted to c.j.hart@herts.ac.uk before the end of February 2011. Papers will be selected by the editorial board based on quality, currency and relevance to the theme of UK-CLC3 - language, mind and reality.

Author Information

Please include name, affiliation and email.

Format

Please send contributions as Word documents. Articles should be single spaced throughout. Leave one line space between paragraphs. Do not use tabs or spaces to indent new paragraphs.

Structure

Your contribution should be structured following the numerical system which means 1. or 1.1. or 1.1.1. Only subchapters up to the third level are accepted (hence no 1.2.3.1).

Notes

Please use numbered endnotes rather than footnotes.

Figures and Tables

Figures and tables should appear in the article. They should be captioned and numbered (consecutively throughout the article rather than according to chapters or subchapters).

Quotations and References

Short quotes should appear in the main text inside single quotation marks. Quotations longer than 3 lines should be indented in the text and appear without quotation marks.

References should conform to the Harvard system of referencing. References should appear at the end of the article in alphabetical order by author's surname. Multiple references to the same author should be listed in chronological order (where necessary using YEARa, YEARb etc.).
